**MELBOURNE STARS V SYDNEY SIXERS
LIBRARY FACT SHEET**

Introduction

The Big Bash League (BBL) comprises eight teams including two from both Melbourne and Sydney and one each from Perth, Adelaide, Hobart and Brisbane. In the first tournament (2011-12 - BBL01), each team played the seven others once (28 matches) followed by two semi-finals and a final which was won by the Sydney Sixers. In the following seasons the number of matches played by each team was gradually increased and from the 2019-20 season (BBL09) each team has played the seven others twice; a 56-match home and away series. A new five-team finals series was introduced in the 2019-20 season. **The Eliminator** is played between the fourth and fifth-placed teams with the loser eliminated; **The Qualifier** between first and second; **The Knock-out** between third and the winner of the Eliminator; **The Challenger** between the winner of the Knock-out and the loser of the Qualifier leading to **The Final** between the winner of The Qualifier and the winner of The Challenger.

Rule Changes - Introduced for the 2020-21 Season (BBL10)

The Power Surge: A two-over period during which the fielding team is allowed only two players outside the inner fielding circle. The batting side can call for this at any point from the eleventh over of its innings, and

The X-Factor player: A player named as either the twelfth or thirteenth player on the team sheet, could come into the match after the tenth over of the first innings and replace any player who was yet to bat or had bowled no more than one over, and

The Bash Boost was a bonus point awarded at the ten-over mark of the second innings of a match to the team with the higher score at that mark. If the scores were tied the teams each got 0.5 points. The point would also be split if the second innings was delayed or interrupted or the match was abandoned.

Rule Changes – Introduced for the 2022-23 Season (BBL12)

The innings clock: the fielding team must start the last over inside 79 minutes otherwise it will have to field with only four fielders outside the “circle” for the remaining overs.

The Decision Review System: one challenge of an umpire’s decision allowed per innings.

The Bash Boost and the X-Factor player introduced for BBL10 have been dropped.

Awarding of Points for Matches

Win: 3 points, **Tie:** (if Super-Over does not yield a result) 1.5 points each team, **Loss 0**, **No Result** (but play started): 1.5 each, **Match Abandoned** without a ball bowled: 1.5 each, **Match Abandoned** without a ball bowled (but toss made): 1.5 each.
