# **2023 AFL GRAND FINAL**

## 100 YEARS AGO: THE 1923 VFL GRAND FINAL - ESSENDON V FITZROY

The 1923 grand final was to be played on October 13, but such was the state of the ground, it was delayed one week. When the grand final did take place Essendon had only played one match in the last six weeks due to their having a bye in the final home and away round, and then only a single match in the finals. They made a selection surprise by including 33 year old George Rawle, coach of Essendon Juniors, for his first League game.

Essendon began the match well and were on top for the first 15 minutes or so. They kicked the first goal of the game when full forward Greg Stockdale posted his 67th major for the season – then a League record. A second goal in the quarter gave Stockdale 68 for the season. Fitzroy, with Jimmy Freake performing well up forward, gradually got back into the game and at quarter time they were one point ahead.

In general play, Essendon seemed to have the better of the second quarter but they missed several chances and managed only one goal and eight behinds. Fitzroy kicked two goals two and maintained their one point advantage at the long break. In the third quarter, Essendon added two goals through Justin McCarthy and Frank Maher, while Fitzroy were held goalless. Although the Dons had dominated the quarter they still only led by 10 points at the final break and Fitzroy went into the final stanza still feeling that they had a chance to take the flag.

Soon after the final term commenced Stockdale missed a chance to boot another goal for Essendon and, soon after, Clive Fergie of Fitzroy passed to Harold Carter, who registered a goal. Fitzroy were now only five points behind. The game see-sawed for a while but with less than ten minutes remaining, and Essendon still in the lead by four points, Charlie Hardy (Essendon) made a brilliant pass to Frank Maher, who dodged the pack and goaled. Further Fitzroy attacks were repelled by the Essendon defence and a goal on the run from George Shorten eventually sealed the game for the Dons. In the *Australasian* Jack Worrall, their football correspondent who was a famous former Fitzroy player and Carlton coach, summed up the game as follows:

"... while there was not much in it, Essendon was the better and more finished band. And strange as it may appear their bye at the end of the first round and the postponement on October 13, was all in their favour. Their brilliant little men were feeling the strain when the first round ceased, and needed a spell badly. The easing of strenuous Saturday matches had been the means of restoring their old-time brilliancy, and was a great factor in winning them the premiership. With Fitzroy the case was altogether different. They are big and solid players, and require a lot of work. As, in the previous season, they had timed their run nicely, and unmistakably gave evidence in their play last Saturday that they were going off. They played with much of their old-time tenacity, yet had lost a lot of that wonderful vim which is such a marked characteristic of their play. It was noticeable all through while the spirit was willing the flesh failed to respond in the old dauntless manner, and they were beaten by a better team on the day."
