### Australia v Pakistan in Tests at all Grounds

**Pakistan** came into being following partition of the Indian sub-continent in 1947. Pakistan was divided into two parts: East and West Pakistan. West Pakistan broke away in 1971 to become **Bangladesh**. Pakistan played its first Test match in October, 1952 against India at Delhi, losing by an innings and 70 runs. Bangladesh played its first Test match in November, 2000 also against India at Dhaka, losing by nine wickets.
