2023/24 BBL MELBOURNE STARS V SYDNEY SIXERS

INTRODUCTION

The Big Bash League (BBL) comprises eight teams including two from both Melbourne and Sydney and one each from Perth, Adelaide, Hobart and Brisbane. In the first tournament (2011-12 - BBL01), each team played the seven others once (28 matches) followed by two semi-finals and a final, which was won by the Sydney Sixers. In the seasons that followed the number of matches played by each team was gradually increased and, from the 2019-20 season (BBL09) to the 2022-23 season (BBL12), each team played the seven others twice – a 56-match home and away series. A five-team finals series was introduced in the 2019-20 season. For the 2023-24 season, the number of home and away matches has been reduced to 40 and the finals to a four-team series. The finals series will commence with the Qualifier between the top two teams, the winner advancing directly to the Final. The third and fourth teams will then play in the Knockout, the loser being eliminated and the winner advancing to play the loser of the Qualifier in the Challenger. The winner of the Challenger earns the right to play the winner of the Qualifier for the BBL title in the Final match.

AWARDING OF POINTS FOR MATCHES

Win: 3 points, **Tie:** (if Super-Over does not yield a result) 1.5 points each team, **Loss** 0, **No Result** (but play started): 1.5 each, **Match Abandoned** without a ball bowled: 1.5 each, **Match Abandoned** without a ball bowled (but toss made): 1.5 each.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN THE BALL HITS THE ROOF AT MARVEL STADIUM?

Batters will no longer be automatically awarded six runs for hitting the roof at Marvel Stadium under changes to Cricket Australia's playing conditions introduced for the 2023-24 season. The new rule, which will be in place for BBL13, will leave it up to the umpires to decide if six runs should be awarded, depending upon whether in their opinion the ball was going to clear the boundary. It is the third time that this rule has been changed since the BBL competition started in 2011 and comes after two skied shots hit the Marvel Stadium roof in the match between the Melbourne Stars and Melbourne Renegades last season.

HIGHEST INDIVIDUAL SCORE



Marcus Stoinis scored 147 not out for the Melbourne Stars in the match against Sydney Sixers at the MCG on January 12, 2020. This is the highest individual score made in a Stars versus Sixers match to date. At the time it was also the highest score ever recorded in the BBL. Team mate Glenn Maxwell broke this record in BBL11, when he scored 154 not out against the Hobart Hurricanes at the MCG on January 19, 2022.
