

The Melbourne Cricket Club extends entry entitlements to Full members who are of affiliated reciprocal clubs/venues on a short term visit to Australia.

Associate, guest and corporate memberships have no access rights. Please note that if you hold multiple membership cards that only one card can be used for reciprocal rights.

Members and their guests are required to adhere to the Members' Reserve <u>dress code</u> at all times while attending matches. In addition to the dress code, the <u>MCC Code of Conduct</u> has been developed to provide clear guidance on the standards of behaviour expected of both members and their guests while in attendance.

Ticketing & Eligibility Requirements

Reserved Seat Ticket Application

Members must produce their Full membership card, a Letter of Introduction from their club, as well as identification confirming their residency outside Australia before any reciprocal access or sale of visitor tickets will proceed.

Reserved seat ticket applications will open <u>here</u> via the MCC website on October 7, 2025 at 10am AEDT. Reserved seat tickets will be allocated on a first-in, best-dressed basis. Tickets are subject to availability and capacity. Ticketek service and handling fee inclusive of GST applies. Once your application is received, please allow 5–7 business days to receive a payment link and your tickets.

General Admission Access

Members can enjoy free general admission by collecting a temporary pass on the day at the Gate 2 Membership Services windows. Please note that general admission visitor tickets will



only be available at the membership windows on the day and are subject to availability. Members must produce their Full membership card, a Letter of Introduction from their club, as well as identification confirming their residency outside Australia.

Boxing Day Test Day 1-3 Arrangements

Due to the expected high demand, reciprocal members will not have access to the MCC Members' Reserve on Days 1–3 of the Boxing Day Test.

However, we are pleased to advise that we have secured a limited number of public seats (Bay M50) next to the Members Reserve for Full members of our reciprocal clubs and their guests. Tickets will be allocated on a first-in, best-dressed basis with a maximum of four tickets per member (one reciprocal member + 3 guests) at a cost of \$249 per ticket + a \$9 transaction fee.
