# **AUSTRALIA V INDIA IN TESTS AT MCG**

**India** played its first Test in 1932 against England at Lord's and its first home Test, also against England, at Bombay (now Mumbai) in 1933. India was the sixth country to play Test Cricket. India first played Australia in Tests during the Australian summer of 1947/48. Two Tests of the five-match series were played at the MCG, both being won by Australia. Australia played its first Test in India in 1956 on the way home from an Ashes tour of England; winning two of the three Tests played with the third being drawn.
