# 2024/25 BIG BASH LEAGUE MELBOURNE STARS V MELBOURNE RENEGADES

### THE BBL: A SHORT HISTORY

Twenty20 cricket began around the cricket world in the early years of this century. Initially a six-team state-based competition was set-up in Australia. In the 2011-12 season the city franchise-based tournament, The Big Bash League (BBL), was established. The BBL comprised eight teams including two from both Melbourne and Sydney. In the 2011-12 tournament (BBL01) each team played the seven others once (28 matches) followed by two semi-finals and a final which was won by the Sydney Sixers. In the second season each team played six others once and one twice (32 matches) followed by the finals. This allowed both Melbourne and Sydney to introduce the "local derby" with a resulting boost in attendances.

In the following seasons the number of home-and-away matches increased and all teams played each other twice  $(56 \, \text{matches})$  starting in 2017-18. From the 2019-20 season the existing finals format was replaced by a five-team final series as follows: The Eliminator (fourth v fifth); The Qualifier (first v second), The Knock-out (third v winner of Eliminator), The Challenger (winner of Knock-out v loser of Qualifier) and the Final (winner of Qualifier v winner of Challenger.

Further changes have been made from the 2023-24 season (BBL13). The number of home-and-away matches was reduced from 56 to 40 with each team playing 10 matches (four teams being played once and three twice). "The Eliminator" final was dropped with only the top four teams playing finals.

**Note**: Tied matches are decided by a "Super Over" bowled to each team at match end. The result is included in either the Won or Lost columns. AT signifies a match being abandoned without a ball being bowled but with the toss being made. NR signifies a No Result match.

The Scorchers have the best record relating to winning and runner-up in the tournament – in the twelve years to date they have won five and been runner-up three times and beaten twice in semi-finals and knock-out. They have only failed to reach the finals in two seasons. Their winning match ratio – 61.78% is well ahead of all other competitors except the Sixers (58.71%). The Sixers have the next best record; winning three pennants, being runner-up four times and being in the finals ten seasons out of the thirteen to date. The Heat have won two tournaments, while three teams (Renegades, Strikers and Thunder) have won one tournament. The Stars and Hurricanes have yet to win the BBL. The Stars have an interesting record; being in the finals on eight occasions including runner-up three times without ultimate success. They have not played in the finals since BBL09.
