

Members Reserve

ACCESS AND SEATING

The MCC Members Reserve consists of four levels of seating within the Northern Stand, with a capacity of almost 23,000 (including standing room). The Reserve can be accessed by Gate 2, near the corner of Jolimont Terrace and Jolimont Street.

Full and Restricted members as well as annual guest cardholders have access to the MCC Reserve for all 2020 AFL Premiership Season. Provisional members can also access the Reserve for selected matches. Access and arrangements for the AFL Finals Series will be communicated to members once scheduling is confirmed.

All MCG event days have been categorised according to the expected demand from members and their guests to attend that day. These categories determine the access that Provisional members have to the Reserve, as well as the ability for all categories of members to purchase visitor tickets, obtain Balcony and Long Room passes and access dining facilities.

Note: Annual guest cardholders have the same access rights as a visitor.

The table below provides an overview of what is available to Members in each event category. A fixture with event categories for each MCG match in the 2020 AFL Premiership Season is located on the back page.

Note – Tickets, passes, dining and access to the Reserve are subject to availability.

BALCONY SEATING

The majority of seating on Level 2 and all seating on Level 3 in the MCC Reserve is allocated for members, as well as guests with a Long Room or Balcony pass.

Seating on these balconies is issued on a first-in, first-served basis; once a seat has been chosen, those in attendance will be issued with a reserved seat ticket. Balcony passes can be obtained (subject to match category) in order for guests to access balcony seating on Levels 2 and 3, including the Frank Grey Smith Bar on Level 3.

LONG ROOM

The Long Room is only accessible for members and guests aged 18 or older. Dress regulations apply for the Long Room (see page 7).

A Long Room pass can be obtained for guests aged 18 or older, which provides access to the Long Room, Frank Grey Smith Bar and Balcony seating on Levels 2 and 3 of the Reserve.

BALCONY AND LONG ROOM PASS CONDITIONS

Members can apply for Balcony or Long Room passes depending on the category of the match and subject to availability.

Applications for Balcony and Long Room passes open at 9.00am on the Monday two weeks prior to each round, and close at 5.00pm on the Tuesday prior to the match.

Applications will be processed in order of receipt and are accepted via the MCC website or email.

There is a limit of 10 successful advanced applications per member for the full season. Members who do not collect their allocated passes on more than one occasion without providing prior notice to the Club will be excluded from making further applications.

Any passes not allocated in advance will be available for collection on match day from the ticket window on the left hand side of Gate 2.



MISUSE OF MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Membership cards are for individual use only and are strictly non-transferrable under any circumstances.

It is the member's responsibility to ensure their card is secure at all times. Misuse of membership cards may result in suspension or expulsion of a member.

Random checks of photo ID membership cards will be undertaken at the turnstiles and throughout the Reserve during the season.

LOST, STOLEN OR FORGOTTEN MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Members who lose, damage or have their membership card stolen must notify the Club as soon as possible. Unless a police report is provided, a \$25 fee is payable to have the card replaced.

A member who forgets their membership card on an event day may obtain an entry ticket, subject to appropriate identification verification by a Membership Services staff member at Gate 2. There is a fee of \$10 for this procedure.

50-YEAR MEMBERS

The MCC provides a reserved seating area (N42) and the John Landy Room, both on Level 2, for the exclusive use of MCC members of 50 or more years standing. The introduction of guests into the room and seating area is subject to demand. The mobility impaired entry at the side of Gate 2 may be used by 50-year members and one guest to access the Reserve.

MARVEL STADIUM AND INTERSTATE VENUES

Limited reciprocal privileges are available for Full members on a short visit to selected interstate clubs and venues. More details are available at mcc.org.au/reciprocal.

MCC members may purchase two tickets (one for themselves, one for a guest) to the Level 2 Gold Reserve seating at Marvel Stadium for the 2020 AFL Premiership Season, subject to availability.

These can be purchased via Ticketmaster or at Gate 7 of Marvel Stadium on match days, subject to availability.

Tickets will be available from 9.00am on the Friday of the week prior to the match.

Behaviour

Members and guests in the MCC Reserve are expected to observe a standard of behaviour that is socially acceptable and in keeping with the standards befitting the Club.

Whilst barracking for your team is encouraged, members and guests are expected to respect others within the vicinity. Aggressive behaviour, bad language and racist or offensive remarks will not be tolerated under any circumstance.

Members are reminded that they are responsible for the behaviour of their guests, or inappropriate behaviour by members or guests may result in suspension or cancellation of memberships.

Members who witness inappropriate behaviour are urged to report the matter to the nearest staff member or via the ground's anti-social behaviour reporting text message service (**0409 117 621**).

Ticketing

VISITOR TICKETS

Full and Restricted members are entitled to up to four tickets for visitor tickets for each game (excluding the ANZAC Day match, where a limit of up to two tickets applies). Provisional members are able to purchase visitor tickets for selected matches. See the membership table on page two for details.

CHILDREN Visitor tickets can be obtained for children:	AGED UNDER SIX YEARS: Free of charge and no ticket required	AGED SIX TO 14 YEARS: Visitor child ticket required

Note – During the 2020 AFL Premiership Season, children can enter the stadium free of charge on Sundays, however they will still require a nil-valued ticket to enter the MCC Reserve. These tickets will form part of the member's total visitor ticket allowance.

RESERVED SEATS

Members may purchase reserved seats for themselves and their guests for matches in the 2020 AFL Premiership Season (subject to availability and match classification).

Reserved seats incur a \$10 charge (plus applicable Ticketek fees). Reserved seats must be purchased in the same transaction as visitor tickets.

Reserved seats will go off-sale one hour prior to gates opening. Any unallocated seats are made available on a walk-up basis.

ACCESSIBLE SEATING & COMPANION CARDS

Reserved accessible seating, including wheelchair spaces for mobility-impaired patrons and their carers (with a companion card) is available via Ticketek's accessible booking line (1300 665 915), at agencies or in-person at the Club. Spaces will also be available on match days on a first-come, first-served basis.

Companions (of either a member or a guest) receive free entry to the Reserve – for more details visit companioncard.org.au

Food & Beverage

Members who use their MCC Plus membership card receive a 5 per cent rebate on food and beverage purchased within the MCC Reserve.

A number of additional takeaway food outlets are also available throughout the Reserve.

Members and guests may only consume drinks within dedicated bar areas. Due to safety regulations, patrons may be required to queue to gain entry to bars at various times.

MEMBERS DINING ROOM & JIM STYNES GRILL

Applications for the Members Dining Room and Jim Stynes Grill open at 9.00am on the Monday two weeks prior to each round. Applications close at 5.00pm the following day.

Registrations can be made through the MCC website or by calling the Club on (03) 9657 8888. At the time of registering members will be required to provide:

- Name
- Membership number
- Number of people dining (including membership numbers of other members in the group)
- Preferred dining time


When registrations exceed room capacity a ballot will be conducted and all registered members will be notified of the outcome. Members who are unsuccessful in the ballot may be offered priority access to other match day dining facilities. This will be communicated following the ballot if applicable.

The number of guests permitted for dining at each match is outlined in the table on page 2.

Note – Members should purchase visitor tickets in advance as dining bookings do not guarantee entry to the Reserve if visitor tickets sell out.

DRESS STANDARDS

Members Reserve

The Club's dress standards will be strictly enforced during the 2020 AFL Premiership Season. To avoid embarrassment at the turnstiles, members should ensure that their attire, and that of their guests, is in accordance with the areas of the MCC Members Reserve planned to attend.



ACCEPTABLE

The minimum standard dress to enter the MCC Members Reserve is neat casual for men and women. Males aged 15 and over must wear a collared shirt, even if worn under a collared sweater or jacket, at all times.



NOT ACCEPTABLE — MEN

- T-shirts, singlets, crew neck tops (skivvies are acceptable)
- Any form of sports shorts or board shorts
- Thongs, scuffs, dilapidated footwear, gumboots, slippers and ugg boots
- Torn or ripped garments (even if 'designer' tears)
- Tracksuit pants
- Any clothing displaying obscene or offensive messages

NOT ACCEPTABLE — WOMEN

- Any form of sportswear
- Bikini tops and tops showing bare midriff
- Thongs, scuffs, dilapidated footwear, gumboots, slippers and ugg boots
- Torn or ripped garments (even if 'designer' tears)
- Tracksuit pants
- Any clothing displaying obscene or offensive messages

NOT ACCEPTABLE BECAUSE:

Man: Torn jeans, thongs, no collared shirt **Woman:** Sportswear

PLEASE NOTE:

- Notwithstanding the dress standards outlined, management reserves the right to refuse entry to any person considered unsuitably attired.
- No caps, hats or beanies are to be worn in the Frank Grey Smith Bar or Jim Stynes Grill.
- National costume and religious requirements are acceptable in the Reserve, Members Dining Room and Long Room.


DRESS STANDARDS

Long Room and Members Dining Room



ACCEPTABLE

The dress standard for men in the Long Room and Members Dining Room is a lounge suit or tailored jacket, shirt, tie, slacks (tailored chinos acceptable) and dress shoes. Women are expected to dress to a similar standard.



NOT ACCEPTABLE BECAUSE:

Man: Zippered/waist length-jacket, no tie **Woman:** Jeans, tank top, casual sandals



NOT ACCEPTABLE — MEN

- Sports shoes, sandals and shoes without socks
- Open-neck shirts or shirts without collars
- Pullovers or cardigans (without a jacket), rugby tops and football guernseys (even if wearing a tie)
- Jeans, cargo pants or non-tailored slacks
- Parkas, duffle coats, wind-breakers, tracksuit tops, golf and yachting weatherproofs, waist-length jackets (including bomber jackets), denim jackets, zippered jackets, anoraks and driz-a-bones
- Hats, caps and any other headwear unless part of national or religious dress

NOT ACCEPTABLE — WOMEN

- Tops or dresses showing bare midriff
- Tank tops
- Leggings or shorts (footless tights are acceptable if dress or skirt of appropriate length is worn over the top)
- Any form of sports shoe and casual sandals
- Jeans, cargo pants or non-tailored slacks
- Parkas, duffle coats, wind-breakers, tracksuit tops, golf and yachting weatherproofs, waist-length jackets (including bomber jackets) denim jackets, zippered jackets, anoraks and driz-a-bone
