Tickets & Entry Information Box Office/Ticket Collection	
	Only tickets purchased through our official ticketing partner, Ticketek Australia, are valid for this event. If you have purchased tickets through any other source, they may not be valid, and you may not be permitted into the event. You may be able to purchase replacement tickets from the box office; however, availability is not guaranteed.
	Our staff at the box office will be unable to provide you with a refund for tickets

purchased from an outlet other than Ticketek Australia.

Bag Policy	Bags must be small enough to fit under your seat. All bags must be presented

Security Checks	As a Condition of Entry into the MCG, all patrons will be subject to bag searches, wanding and a ticket check process, which will be performed at all entrance points to the venue.
	We encourage patrons to arrive early, be patient and limit the number of items brought to this event to alleviate queue times and avoid any disappointment.

Conditions of Entry	In addition to the MCG Conditions of Entry the following items are also not permitted into the venue for this event:

	 Weapons or projectiles of any kind Any item considered a danger to the Artist or the public Plastic bottles brought into the Stadium or purchased at Stadium outlets will need to have their tops removed
Arena Access	Only patrons with tickets onto the arena will be permitted on the arena. All tickets will be checked by staff prior to entry onto the arena.
	Billy Joel One Night Only in Australia 2022 is a licensed all ages event. This is a licensed, loud music event, staged over a long time and we do not recommend attendance by children aged 5 years and under. Children 14 and under must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times and have purchased a valid ticket. No concession tickets will be available for children, they must have a ticket.
	Access to the arena is via the main aisles in the lower seating bowl. If you need assistance onto the arena, please seek the assistance of one of our Event Staff.
	The gate indicated on your ticket is the closest entry to the arena, however if you are unsure, please see one of our Event Staff.
Facilities & Amenities Access Assistance	For patrons requiring assistance to the arena this is via lifts 5/6/7 which can be found inside Gate 2. From here a staff member will escort you to the general admission area.
