

50-Year Members' Reserved Seating John Landy Room

Rules and Regulations

1. Members' Reserve

The Melbourne Cricket Club (MCC) provides a reserved seating area (the rear section of bay N42) and the John Landy Room, both on Level 2, for the exclusive use of MCC 50-Year members, Hans Ebeling Award winners and Certificate of Merit recipients. Note: The term 50-Year member encompasses the other categories in the context of this document.

2. MCC Rules

All applicable rules and regulations of the MCC must be observed.

3. Dress

Dress requirements in the John Landy Room are the same as for the Long Room and Members Dining Room. That is, jacket and tie for men and equivalent standard for women. Note: Members dressed in casual attire may enter the room briefly to obtain their seat tickets but are not to dwell in the room and utilise any of the room's facilities. *Please note that in the event of extreme warm weather, jackets may be optional and this decision will be advised by the staff member in the John Landy Room on the day of the match.

4. Organisation

The MCC will provide staff to run the John Landy Room and control seating arrangements on match days. Members should obtain available seating either in advance of match day via Ticketek or from the staff member in the John Landy Room no later than 15 minutes before the advertised time of the match starting.

5. Evidence of Membership

For the benefit of staff, members will be required to present their MCC 50-Year membership card when requesting seats or entering the John Landy Room. The wearing of the 50-Year members' tie/scarf or lapel badge is also encouraged.

6. Seating (Bay N42, Level 2)

Up to approximately 60% of the seating available in the 50-Year member area is available for purchase by 50-Year members for themselves and their guests in advance via Ticketek (subject to availability). The remaining seating will be available on an unreserved basis on the match day.

50-Year members can obtain seat tickets for the unreserved seating available from the staff member in the John Landy Room (subject to availability). Please note that seating for 50-Year members' guests may be limited for some of the more popular matches.

7. John Landy Room

Unfortunately, on some match days, the limited space in the John Landy Room might not allow for the admission of guests who have a seat in the 50-Year area. A notice in the room to this effect will inform members on those days. When guests are allowed, they must have their seat ticket for identification. Only guests with seats in the 50-Year area will be admitted to the Landy Room.

Food and drinks provided by the club must be consumed in the room.

8. Members with Accessible requirements

If any 50-Year member requiring a carer with a Companion Card wishes to reserve a seat or a space for a wheelchair in advance for any match, this can be arranged by contacting Ticketek Accessible Seating – 1300 665 915.

9. Television Set

Two television sets are available in the room and one will be tuned to the match taking place at the ground. The other set will be tuned to a channel at the discretion of the staff member on duty.
