

#### Misuse of membership cards

Membership cards are for personal use only and are strictly non-transferrable under any circumstances.

It is the members' responsibility to ensure their card is secure at all times.

Misuse of membership cards may result in suspension or expulsion of a member.

Random checks of photo ID membership and digital membership cards will be undertaken at the turnstiles and throughout the Members' Reserve during the cricket season.

#### **Code of Conduct**

Members and guests in the MCC Member's Reserve are expected to observe a standard of behaviour that is socially acceptable and in keeping with the standards befitting the Club, guided by the MCC Code of Conduct.

Members should take particular note that the Club has mandated an update to the Club's Disciplinary Penalty Guide in relation to racist behaviour or any comments of a vilifying nature. The Club has adopted a zero tolerance approach towards racist behaviour and comments, and members (or their guests) found guilty of this conduct will now face expulsion from the Club.

Welcome to the 2023/24 Cricket Season at the MCG

The Melbourne Cricket Club is pleased to welcome members to the Members' Reserve for the 2023/24 cricket season.

The cricket action at the 'G kicks off with two Sheffield Shield matches – between Victoria and New South Wales and Victoria and Queensland – in October and November respectively.

Then, in late November, the MCG will host its first ever standalone WBBL match between the Melbourne Stars and Melbourne Renegades. Our first match of the BBL season will be on Wednesday December 13 as the Stars take on the reigning premiers, the Perth Scorchers.

The beloved Boxing Day Test will see Australia host Pakistan for the first time since 2016. Always a highlight on the MCG calendar, we can't wait to welcome members to the MCC Reserve for what is sure to be an enthralling Test match.

The New Year sees three consecutive BBL matches – including the Melbourne derby on January 2, before a One-Day International between Australia and the West Indies.

### **Member Access**

All MCG match days have been categorised according to their expected demand from members and their guests to attend the Members' Reserve.

Full and Restricted members will have access to all match days during the 2023/24 cricket season. Long Room and Balcony pass conditions for visitors are outlined under match details on the following pages.

For a small number of match days when the attendance of Full and Restricted members and their guests is forecast to be high, Provisional members may have limited or no access to the Reserve.

Members booking reserved seats on Level 2 will be limited to the same number of visitors that apply for Balcony passes. Please note that all members and visitors with a Level 2 reserved seat do not require a Long Room or Balcony pass to access their seats, however, a Long Room pass (subject to availability) will be required for visitors wishing to access the Long Room.

The following table provides an overview of what is available to members in each category including Provisional access, visitor tickets, dining access and Long Room or Balcony pass conditions. A list of match days and categories can be found on the next page.

# **Match Details**

Match days at the MCG will be classified as a Category 1, 2 or 3 match day in accordance with attendance estimates and expected demand of amenities by members.

Reserved seats, access to the Reserve and passes are all subject to availability.

Balcony and Long Room passes will not be required for visitors to access Level 2 and 3 seating for Big Bash League matches.

# Members' Information

#### Reserved Seats

Members may purchase reserved seating for themselves and visitors in accordance with match category conditions.

Any unallocated reserved seating will become available to members and visitors on a general admission basis, subject to capacity and availability.

Provisional members may also purchase reserved seats for all match days, excluding the first day of the Boxing Day Test, subject to match category conditions.

#### Visitor Tickets

Full and Restricted members may purchase visitor tickets for each cricket match at the MCG.

There is a limit of two visitor tickets per Full and Restricted member for Day 1 of the Test and a limit of four per Full and Restricted member for all other days of international and domestic cricket. The limit for Provisional members is two per member for Category 2 match days, and four for Category 3 match days.

A decision on the timing of the on-sale of visitor tickets for Day 5 of the Test will be made during the match and communicated to members via email.

Visitor tickets for Sheffield Shield matches will be available to purchase on match day from Membership Services at Gate 2.

#### **Alcohol Free Bay**

Additional alcohol-free bays have been allocated within the Members' Reserve for matches during the 2023/24 cricket season.

Alcohol-free seating areas will be allocated in both unreserved and reserved seating areas.

- M41 (reserved) & M42 (unreserved)
- N41 (reserved) & N48 (unreserved)
- Q44 & Q45 rows A-F (reserved)

Note: Any unallocated reserved seating in alcohol free bays will be made available for alcohol free walk up seating.

# Accessible Seating & Companion Cards

Reserved seating for accessible patrons, including wheelchair spaces, and their carers (with a government issued Companion Card) is available via Ticketek by completing the online form at help.ticketek.com.au, by calling 1300 665 915 or in-person at the Club. Unreserved spaces will also be available on a first-come, first-served basis on match days.

Companions (of either a member or guest) receive free entry to the Reserve. For more details visit companioncard.org.au.

#### **Ticketing Conditions**

- Tickets can be purchased via the Ticketek website (ticketek.com.au/mccmembers), by calling the MCC members priority line 1300 136 961, at Ticketek agencies or the Membership Services Office at the Club, Monday to Friday, 9.00am to 5.00pm. Tickets may also be purchased at the Gate 2 tickets windows on match days, subject to availability.
- When purchasing tickets at a Ticketek agency, Membership Services Office or Gate 2, your membership card will be required.
- Only members can collect pre-purchased tickets from the right of Gate 2 on match day. Visitors cannot collect pre-purchased tickets.
- A limit of 10 tickets per transaction applies.
- Members are expected to be in attendance with visitors.

# Members' Dining

#### International & BBL

Applications for dining in the Members' Dining Room and Jim Stynes Grill can be made through the MCC website on each event page or by calling the Club on (03) 9657 8888.

When registrations for the Boxing Day Test and International ODI exceed room capacity, a ballot will be conducted and all registered members will be notified of the outcome.

At the time of registering members will be required to provide:

- Name
- Member number
- Number of people dining (including member number of other members in the group)
- · Preferred dining time

The number of visitors permitted for dining at each match is outlined in the table on page 4.

Members and visitors who secure dining in the Members' Dining Room (as well as Committee Room by Grossi when available to members) will also access a Level 2 reserved seat as part of their booking. To gain entry, members will scan in with their membership card and visitors are able to obtain a general admission visitors ticket.

Bookings for BBL/WBBL matches will be processed in a first-in, first-served manner from the dates listed on page 5.

#### **Additional Dining**

On select match days, the Club may have access to other dining facilities within or close to the Members' Reserve.

Members who are unsuccessful in the ballot will be offered priority access to attractive match day dining packages in these facilities. This will be communicated following the ballot if applicable.

#### Sheffield Shield

The Committee Room by Grossi will operate as the main dining room for lunch on Sheffield Shield and One-Day Cup match days (excluding weekends). The Long Room will operate on weekends.

The Trumble Bar & Café will be available for casual dining at all matches. No reservations are required.



# DRESS STANDARDS


The Club's dress standards will again be strictly enforced during the cricket season. To avoid any embarrassment at the turnstiles, please ensure that your attire and that of your guests is appropriate for the areas of the Reserve you plan to attend. Notwithstanding the dress standards outlined, management reserves the right to refuse entry to any person considered unsuitably attired.

#### **MCC RESERVE**

The minimum standard dress to enter the Reserve is neat casual for both men and women.

A key requirement for males 15 years and over is that they must wear a collared shirt (even if worn under a collared sweater or jacket) at all times in the Reserve.

Please note that caps, hats and beanies are not to be worn in the Jim Stynes Grill.

#### **NOT ACCEPTABLE DRESS STANDARDS**

#### MEN

- Thongs, scuffs, dilapidated footwear, gumboots, slippers and ugg boots.
- T-shirts, singlets, torn or ripped clothes, even if 'designer' tears.
- Crew neck tops (skivvies are acceptable).
- Any form of sports shorts and board shorts.
- Tracksuit pants.
- Any clothing displaying obscene or offensive messages.

#### WOMEN

- Thongs, scuffs, dilapidated footwear, gumboots, slippers and ugg boots.
- Torn or ripped clothes, even if 'designer' tears.
- Any form of sportswear.
- Tracksuit pants.
- Bikini tops and tops showing bare midriff.
- Any clothing displaying obscene or offensive messages.

# DRESS STANDARDS

# LONG ROOM, MEMBERS' DINING ROOM AND JOHN LANDY ROOM (JOHN LANDY ROOM FOR 50-YEAR MEMBERS ONLY)

The dress standard for males in the Long Room, Members' Dining Room and John Landy Room is a lounge suit or tailored jacket, shirt, tie, slacks (tailored chinos acceptable) and dress shoes. Females are expected to dress to a similar high standard. Jackets may be removed during the summer months and national costume and religious requirements such as a clerical collar are acceptable.

Please note that only Members' Reserve dress requirements apply in the Members' Dining Room during Big Bash League matches. Normal dress standards will apply for access to the Long Room.





#### NOT ACCEPTABLE DRESS STANDARDS

#### MEN

- · Any form of sports shoe.
- Sandals and shoes without socks.
- Jeans, cargo pants or non-tailored slacks.
- Open-neck shirts or shirts without collars.
- Parkas, duffle coats, wind-breakers, tracksuit tops, golf and yachting weatherproofs, waist-length jackets including bomber jackets, denim jackets, zippered jackets, puffer jackets, anoraks and driz-a-bones.
- Hats, caps and any other headwear unless part of national or religious dress.
- Pullovers or cardigans (without a jacket), rugby tops and football guernseys, even if wearing a ties.

#### WOMEN

- Any form of sports shoe.
- Tank tops.
- Jeans, cargo pants or non-tailored slacks.
- 'Leggings' or shorts.
- Parkas, duffle coats, wind-breakers, tracksuit tops, golf and yachting weatherproofs, bomber jackets, denim jackets, puffer jackets and anoraks.
- Tops or dresses showing bare midriff.

Please note: footless tights are acceptable if an appropriate length dress or shirt is worn over the top.
